TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By registering to attend the Net Zero Emission Mining WA Conference (*Conference*), either in-person or online, attendees agree to abide by the following terms and conditions.

If you are registering on behalf of another person, it is your responsibility to ensure the attendee is made aware of these terms.

GENERAL

MRIWA may add, withdraw or substitute speakers, modify the advertised program, or vary any other aspect of the Conference.

MRIWA reserves the right to vary audience capacity, location and timing of the Conference, should circumstances change.

ATTENDEE BEHAVIOUR

The Conference is designed with a strong focus on discussion and the program has been developed to provide opportunities for delegate participation.

Attendees are encouraged to express opinions in the designated forums, however hostile, offensive or anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated. MRIWA reserves the right to refuse admission or eject attendees from the Conference for failure to comply with these terms or if, in the opinion of MRIWA or the venue, you represent a security risk, nuisance or annoyance to the running of the Conference.

Attendees must comply with all reasonable verbal or written directions given by MRIWA or the venue.

TICKETING INFORMATION

The Conference is a ticketed event and MRIWA reserves the right to refuse entry to persons unable to provide a valid ticket.

All tickets must be purchased online. Confirmation of attendance will only be sent upon receipt of the completed booking and payment.

Ticket price includes GST and all purchases will incur a 5% booking fee + \$0.99 per ticket.

In-person event

A limited number of first release tickets will be made available at a discounted rate until midnight on 28 August 2021 or until all tickets are sold.

Once first release ticket sales have closed, general release tickets will be available at the non-discounted full price rate.

Discounted and/or complimentary tickets may be made available by MRIWA to sponsors and invited guests.

Conference livestream

Attendees who register as a virtual delegate will receive an access code 3 days prior to the Conference.

This code will provide access to the livestream of the Conference plenary sessions as per the conference program. All session times are in AWST (UTC +8).

COVID-19 INFORMATION

The safety of attendees is our highest priority, and the Conference will abide by national and local health guidelines in place at the time of our event, 13 October 2021.

This may include, but is not limited to:

- Limits on tickets to reflect the capacity restrictions of the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre.
- Mandatory contact register for WA Health Department COVID-19 contact tracing including the SafeWA app scanning of venue QR codes or manual attendee lists.

Postponement or cancellation
